Accessibility

Our approach to making Solten Ventures websites, publications, and other public digital properties more accessible.

1. Our commitment

Solten Ventures is committed to providing digital properties that are usable by as many people as reasonably possible, including people with disabilities.

We consider accessibility an ongoing part of maintaining and improving our websites, publications, forms, and other public digital materials rather than a one-time compliance exercise.

2. Accessibility approach

We aim to design and maintain public-facing digital properties with accessibility principles in mind, including clear structure, readable typography, meaningful navigation, sufficient contrast, keyboard usability, and descriptive alternatives for important non-text content where practical.

3. Standards

Our current objective is to work toward substantial conformance with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 Level AA where those guidelines are applicable to our public digital properties.

Because technologies, third-party services, and our own properties change over time, we do not represent that every page, file, or feature will conform perfectly at all times.

4. Documents and publications

Some research reports, downloadable documents, archived publications, or legacy materials may not provide the same level of accessibility as newer web content. Where feasible, we will consider reasonable improvements or alternative formats when a user identifies a material accessibility barrier.

5. Third-party content and services

Our websites may link to or incorporate third-party platforms, embedded tools, analytics, forms, video, document viewers, or other services that we do not fully control. Accessibility of those third-party services is governed by their own technologies and practices.

6. Compatibility and technical limitations

Accessibility may vary depending on browser, device, assistive technology, operating system, user settings, or temporary technical conditions. Older browsers or uncommon configurations may not provide the same experience as currently supported environments.
